



## 2020 Volleyball FAQs

### **What is the 2020 Volleyball Ticket Purchase and Passes Procedure?**

- SBISD Coaches will give each volleyball player two (2) passes for their parents or guardian that will be used throughout the season.
- Each pass entitles the cardholder to purchase one (1) single game ticket in SBISD – Adults \$3, Students \$1.
- Passes are valid only for the contest involving the school of issue, valid only for the contest involving the sport issued, and valid only at SBISD venues unless an opponent agrees to honor the SBISD pass. The JV/Varsity pass cannot be used to purchase a ticket to enter the 9A/9B school gym, and the 9A/9B pass cannot be used to purchase a ticket to enter the JV/Varsity school gym.
- Lost or stolen passes will not be replaced and are subject to confiscation if misused.

### **What is required for fans to be allowed entry to a Volleyball match?**

- Due to limited seating, fans will not be allowed to purchase a ticket for any match without the correct pass except for JV/Varsity matches at Don Coleman Coliseum.
- Other passes will not be accepted this year for volleyball, such as: Coaches' Association Passes, Faculty ID Badges, Senior Citizen Passes or any pass used in the past.
- Passes are valid only for the contest involving the school of issue, valid only for the contest involving the sport issued, and valid only at SBISD venues unless an opponent agrees to honor the SBISD pass.
  - The JV/Varsity pass cannot be used to enter the 9A/9B school gym, and the 9A/9B pass cannot be used to enter the JV/Varsity school gym.
  - Ticket purchases for JV/Varsity matches that occur at Don Coleman Coliseum will be on a first-come, first-serve basis up to 1,000 tickets unless otherwise specified.
  - SBISD Athletics reserves the right to amend the ticket purchasing policy for rival matches at DCC to ensure that participants' families have access to tickets first.

### **What Health and Safety Protocols will be in Place for Volleyball Matches?**

The following procedures related to SBISD volleyball, based on the public health situation as we understand it today, applies to the 2020 season. These procedures are effective immediately. Changes to the public health situation in the coming months may necessitate changes to these procedures.

- All UIL, TEA and SBISD COVID-19 guidelines, policies, and procedures will be followed to ensure the health, safety and well-being of our students, staff and families.
- All employees, parents, visitors and students three years of age or older must wear face coverings or face shields upon entry to an area where SBISD UIL activities are being conducted and when not actively practicing or playing in a contest.
- We will not need to clear the bleachers between matches. However, we encourage parents and players to exit immediately after their match.
- Participation in interscholastic athletics, whether as a participant or a spectator, is considered a privilege and not a right. Parents and spectators will be removed from the premises and prohibited from attending future contests should they exhibit objectionable behaviors and/or fail to comply with all SBISD, UIL and TEA COVID-19 guidelines.
