
# Navigate Through Title I at Overton Elementary!





#### What is Title 1?

- \* Title I is the largest federally funded program in the United States.
- \* Title I began with the passage of the ESEA (Elementary and Secondary ACT) of 1965. The Current law, ESSA (Every Student Succeeds Acts), signed into law on December 10, 2015 replaces No Child Left Behind.
- \* The goal of Title I is to help ensure that ALL students have an opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach grade level proficiency.



#### What is a Title I School?


- \* Overton receives extra financial assistance in addition to state and local funds based upon the number of students receiving free or reduced price meals. Any school that has at least 40% or more of its students eligible for free or reduced price meals, qualified as a Title I school.
- \* Important note: There is no connection between students receiving Title I services and their eligibility for free or reduced priced meals.



# Our School-Wide Title I Program

\* In our school-wide Title I program, all students are eligible to receive Title I services. Title I funds can be used to hire professionals and/or purchase academic materials and programs. These funds can also be used to provide or enhance parent involvement initiatives that give support to our students and their families. The Overton family is committed to providing an educational experience that promotes academic excellence, positive peer interaction, emotional growth, and open communication.






## Federal Programs Parent Resource Center
