



Dear Parents of Current 12th Grade Students,

Stafford High School 12th grade students will take the ACT on **October 6th, 2020.**

The ACT contains four multiple-choice tests—English, mathematics, reading, and science—and a writing test. These tests are designed to measure skills that are most important for success in postsecondary education and that are acquired in secondary education. The score range for each of the four multiple-choice tests is 1–36. The Composite score is the average of the four test scores rounded to the nearest whole number.

On testing day, students must **report to the back of the school (student lot) by 7:30 am.**

This test will be administered face to face. It is essential that everyone is on time so that we may begin testing by 8:00am. It is a timed test and the start time cannot be delayed. Testing will take approximately 5 hours to complete. *If your student has opted in virtual learning, they may leave after testing is complete.* We encourage students to get a good night's rest and eat a healthy breakfast prior to testing so they are focused and ready.

Please bring:

- Student ID or Form of ID
- Mask (if you do not have one, one will be provided)
- Pencil
- Packaged snack

Prior to participating, students will be screened via questioning by school employees for any new or worsening signs or symptoms of COVID-19. Students will be testing in the gym areas to adhere to 6ft social distancing guidelines.
