PREVENTION

No confirmed cases of COVID-19 among staff or students

- Daily at home self-screening of staff and students prior to entering the building
- Face masks are required for staff and students
- Health prevention measures are in place
- Daily intensive cleaning and frequent cleaning of common areas
- Monitoring virus trends in the community via the health department
- No visitor access

MITIGATION

One or more confirmed case(s) of COVID-19 at one campus/facility

- Persons who came in verified close contact with an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 will personally be contacted and advised to self-quarantine for 14 days
- Affected areas are closed for deep cleaning
- Self-screening of symptoms, prevention information and stay home if ill communications to all persons at the school/facility
- A short-term closure of the campus/facility might be necessary for three days

MODIFIED OPERATIONS

Three or more confirmed COVID-19 cases in one specific area (e.g. classroom) Staff and students of that area will be advised to self-quarantine for 14 days

- Students impacted will move to virtual learning
- Affected area is closed for deep cleaning
- A short-term closure of the facility might be necessary for three days

CAMPUS/FACILITY CLOSURE

COVID-19 cases exceed 5 percent of the in-person campus/facility population OR staff is unable to operate effectively with in-person learning

- Entire campus/facility will be closed for in-person learning with virtual only for a minimum of three (3) days
- All staff and students at this campus/facility may return if symptom free upon determination by the school district and health authorities
- Persons who came in verified close contact with an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 will personally be contacted and advised to self-quarantine for 14 days
- District wide communication to staff/parents with health monitoring guidance

DISTRICT CLOSURE

COVID-19 cases exceed 5 percent of in-person population in two campuses OR staff is unable to operate effectively with in-person learning

- All La Porte ISD facilities closed for in-person learning with virtual only for a minimum of five (5) days
- Staff and students move to virtual learning and work
- Deep cleaning/disinfection of all facilities and school buses
- Extracurricular activities are postponed
