- -If required time or lack of progress in APEX occurs truancy will be filled.
- -Weekly progress reports, generated by APEX, are sent to all parents/guardians.
- -Students need to be working in the APEX curriculum. Searching other sites should be for educational purposes only.
- -Students' written work should be their own. Students who plagiarize work are given one opportunity to redo the work in their own words. Any plagiarism after that will result in a zero for the assignment.
- -OASIS is prideful of the fact that teachers and students respect one another and foster an environment that is positive and safe. Student uniqueness is celebrated, not judged.

Additional Courses:

Art: If your student is interested in being creative, being inspired, and inspiring others, Art is being offered this year on alternating Wednesdays. Virtual projects will be available for your student while they are at home. High school students who participate in this experience every other week will earn .5 credit toward their High School Fine Art requirement (1.0 credit).
