Available Vaccines:

Quadrivalent

For persons 6 months and older • the “regular” flu shot

High Dose Quadrivalent

For persons 65 years and older

Studies have shown that the high-dose flu vaccine is safe and more effective for seniors than the regular flu shot

Flublok

For persons 18 years and older • Suitable for adults with egg allergies

FluMist

For healthy persons 2 - 49 years • the nasal spray vaccine
