

TOPIC KEY - AZTECS - YEAR Five and Six

We would like you to use this grid to choose activities to do in the afternoons at home. Some activities may take you more than one afternoon to complete. For each activity you can represent your work as you wish: you may choose to make a video, power point, poster, model, journal, or diary, write a report or letter. It's totally up to you!

You can choose whichever activity you wish. There are 30 to keep you going throughout this half term, so maybe aim for a minimum of 3 per week.

What are at least 10 benefits of being an Aztec?	Research Aztec settlements and create a 3D model of a typical Aztec home.	Consider what would happen if Aztecs were still alive on Earth today? What would it be like? Show your thinking.	Find out who the Aztecs worshipped. Write a short description.	Use a map to label where the Aztecs came from.
Design an Aztec mask.	What did the Aztecs ever do for us? Find out what the Aztecs invented that we still use today.	How the Aztecs die out?	Write your name using the Aztec alphabet.	Mexico is the former home of the Aztecs. Design and make a Mexican menu.
Pretend to be an archaeologist, you have discovered an ancient Aztec temple. Describe what you find. This could be a video news report.	The Aztecs are known for inventing chocolate. Write about the history of how chocolate was discovered and how it has impacted our lives today.	Make something chocolatey.	Over 11 million people live in Mexico today speaking over 60 different languages. Find out how to say 'Hello' in as many of these languages as you can.	If you were an Aztec what would you wear and what might you be called. Design your own Aztec costume and think of an Aztec name.
