GED Prep Classes

GED preparation classes are designed to help you develop and practice the skills required to pass the GED® Test. The GED tests are in four subjects: Science, Social Studies, Mathematical Reasoning, and Reasoning through Language Arts.

- Those who pass the four GED tests earn a CT State High School Diploma

National External Diploma Program

Students work independently to complete a series of tasks and meet weekly with an assessor to demonstrate progress. This remote program is flexible to meet your needs!

Credit Diploma Program

Students earn academic credit in required subject areas. Upon fulfilling all required and elective requirements, students receive a high school diploma.
