Girls on the Run is a Social and Emotional Wellness program for girls in grades 3-5 and 6-8. We teach life skills through dynamic, conversation-based lessons and running games. The goal of the program is to unleash confidence through accomplishment while establishing a lifetime appreciation of health and fitness.

As many youth face changes and new challenges during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, Girls on the Run offers girls a safe space to have their social emotional well-being supported.

For girls who are missing friends and mentors, GOTR provides connection.

For girls who are feeling fearful or insecure, GOTR provides a space where identifying & embracing emotions is practiced and normalized.

For girls who are missing out on interpersonal skill-building, GOTR teaches relationship & communication skills.

For girls who would benefit from structure & decision making, GOTR encourages goal setting.

HOW IT WORKS:

- Girls meet twice a week for 8 weeks for 60 mins. on Zoom or Google Meet
- Each Virtual Team will be led by two trained volunteer coaches
- Girls will receive an 8 Week Physical Activity Challenge with weekly goals
- Girls will be mailed a colorful journal with activity sheets, t-shirt and medal
- At end of season girls will participate in a special celebratory activity

Choose 1 of 2 virtual teams in Monmouth County that best fits your daughter's schedule. Open to all girls in 3rd-5th grade. Dates & times vary.

The program starts week of September 28th.
The cost is \$125 for the 8 weeks.
