



### Code of Conduct - COVID-19 Supplementary

In order for the Schools to operate as safely and efficiently as possible this September there are some extra requirements with regard to behaviour and school routines. The adherence to these requirements is non negotiable.

- Pupils must follow the one way system when moving around school buildings and move quickly and with purpose.
- Pupils must try to maintain social distancing from each other and from staff.
- **Pupils must wash hands regularly throughout the day and use the sanitiser upon entry into school, into any classroom and into the dining hall.**
- Pupils must not cough in the direction of anyone else and must not spit or chew gum at all. If a pupil is found to have deliberately coughed towards anyone else, spat or is found to be chewing gum, serious sanctions will be imposed.
- Pupils may not congregate in or use the toilets as a social area. No more than 3 people in the toilet at any time.
- All pupils are required to wear a face mask in corridors and other areas where social distancing is impossible e.g. lunch queue. Masks must be plain, preferably reusable and not have any fashion labels or any offensive images on them including weapons/skulls etc.
- Masks will not be required in classrooms and during lunch and breaks where pupils are within bubbles.
- All pupils must follow the guidance for the proper use of wearing masks as instructed.
- All disposable face masks must be placed in the bins provided, with straps broken off when they are discarded.
- The use of masks does not reduce the need for continuing the other actions needed to maintain a safe school, such as good hand and respiratory hygiene and social distancing wherever possible.
- Pupils must adhere strictly to the lunch and break timings.
- Pupils must follow the rules of the lunch hall as directed - where to sit, when to enter and when to leave.
- When queuing for lunch pupils must try to maintain social distancing.

- **Pupils must bring water to lunch as there will not be facilities to get it in the dining hall.**
- Pupils must not swap desks once assigned in the teaching room.
- Pupils must ensure that their teaching base/form room is kept neat and tidy - including their desk area.
- Pupils must ensure that all items they bring to school can be safely stored in and around their desk and chair. There can be no piling of bags and coats at the back of classrooms.
- There must be no eating AT ALL in any rooms other than the dining hall or other designated areas (see break locations).
- Pupils must not operate classroom windows.
- Pupils may not enter the form/tutor room of other pupils AT ALL, nor may they congregate in any area other than those specified: the yard/field/quad. (6F have their own arrangements).
- All pupils must bring in a fully charged chromebook everyday.
- Pupils must bring their own water bottle to school and must not share anyone else's - this includes "skying" from another's bottle.
- Pupils must provide their own pens, pencils, coloured pencils, glue, scissors, calculators etc. and must not share with anyone else.
- On days pupils have games, they may wear their games uniform for the duration of that school day (n.b. there will not be any shower facilities at school).
- Pupils may come to school in their PE kit on the days they have PE, but must get changed into their uniform after the lesson.
