

- determine ⅓ of subject grade in grade 10
- permits access to Qualifikationsphase (at GISSV or any German High School)

Realschulabschluss

- 2 Abschlussarbeiten (written exams) in German and Englisch or Math (in March)
- 1 Oral Exam (in May or June)
- determine ½ of subject grade in grade 10
- permits access to Einführungsphase if grades fulfill some requirements
