Minutes for Last Meeting: To be read and approved next month

Election: By majority vote of those present, Connie Stanger is the newly-elected chair, and Liz Hansen is the newly-elected vice-chair. Norah Baron is secretary.

School Improvement Plan: The school improvement plan (SIP) was approved on March 25, 2020. Principal Keime reviewed the plan as a refresher.

Land Trust Expenditures: Some land trust expenditures were approved previously; additional requests will be submitted and voted upon this school year. Principal Keime reviewed these.

Training: Community Council trainings are generally online. Principal Keime will email Community Council members once these are available.

Start of School: Council members gave feedback as follows:

- Members expressed positives about the start of the school year including students' access to teachers on the hybrid schedule and laptops available to each student.
- It was reported that there are a handful of Covid-19 cases at Clearfield High School. The numbers have decreased over the last two weeks. In the future, the community will be sent notifications when there is a new case in our school. Concerns were voiced about the inability to social-distance when students attend school four days a week starting October 5th,

and questions were raised about online versus in-class options, which are yet to be determined.

- It was suggested that teachers make a wish list for unspent Land Trust money tied to the School Improvement Plan (SIP) such as productivity, swivel cameras, and replacements for students' aging laptops. Principal Keime will survey the faculty.
- On Friday, Principal Keime and our administrators will send a survey to parents regarding upcoming schedule changes.
- For now, dances, concerts, assemblies, plays, sporting events, etc. are limited and available through online ticketing.
- There is a need for Canvas and Summit help for parents. Terra Bingham will create a Canvas tutorial and present it this coming Monday and Tuesday during parent-teacher conferences, and Principal Keime will provide Summit instruction on both days.

Student Government: Virtual assemblies will continue to be viewed by students during their mentoring classes.

Next Meeting: Meetings, in general, are held on the third Wednesday of each month at 4:00 p.m. The next Community Council meeting is on October 21, 2020.
