The Notre Dame Girls Cross Country team earned a win over Holly by a final score of 19-44 in a race run at Riversbend Park. Lexi Fraser notched second career win and set a personal record with a time of 19:58, breaking 20 minutes for the first time in her career. Mariana Ricci, Maddie Monaghan, Anna Hauck, and Allie Dawiedczyk round out the scoring effort for the Irish, all finishing in the top six.

BRONCHOS EDGE OUT IRISH IN DUAL MEET

The Notre Dame Boys Varsity Cross Country team dropped a close 31-24 decision to Holly in a race run at Riversbend Park. Wade Robinson edged out the top Holly runner, setting a new personal record in the process, to win the meet individually with a time of 16:40. Eli Seitzinger, Adam Martin, James Chabot, and Nathan Vogel rounded out the scoring for Notre Dame.
