At the airport

- Working closely with airline partners to understand the safety policies; updating our packing list accordingly
- Researching each airport's own protocols and communicating those in advance of your trip
- For foreseeable future, each traveler with will receive 2 disposable face masks per day in advance of your trip date



Your Course Leader:

- Groups met by a locally-based Course Leader who has been specially trained to keep your group safe
- Will provide a daily destination specific safety briefing to help set expectation for students
- As necessary, may adjust the ratio of Course Leaders to student to allow us to be more agile in the locations we are visiting



On the Motorcoach:

- Continuing to work with only the most reputable companies with the best safety records
- Establishing new loading and unloading procedures to minimize unnecessary passing/contact
- Developing new cleaning schedules for the coach
- Ensuring all are equipped with the necessary amount of hand-sanitizer



Industry Leading Support at Every Step of the Way

At the hotel:

- Working only with our established hotel partners, those that have demonstrated the highest standards in cleanliness.
- Revising check-in procedures to minimize contact with other hotel guests
- Reducing interaction with hotel personnel, including limited daily room service
- Offering affordable upgrade options related to room occupancy
- Will continue to have Night Chaperones stationed on each hallway



The sites we visit:

- Monitoring the situation in all destinations and making adjustments as necessary as protocols related to group travel are changing daily.
- When necessary, changing the final itinerary to accommodate the new way of doing things and to make sure we focus time on the sites where we have the most flexibility
- Ensuring there will be plenty of time for hand-washing breaks
- Modifying all packing lists to meet the new requirements that some sites will have around group management

Meals:

- Leveraging our knowledge and relationships to select only those restaurants that follow the strictest of hygiene practices
- Self-serve buffets will not be used
