Woodlands Welcomes Safia from Kabul

SCHOLARSHIP SUPPORTS
MULTICULTURALITY



The 7000 miles from Kabul, Afghanistan to Lake Forest, Illinois only begin to express the distances Safia Karimi has travelled to her new student life at Woodlands Academy of the Sacred Heart.

This young Afghan woman lived as a refugee in Pakistan where the language she spoke and read was Urdu. She later studied in Afghanistan where the language she spoke and read was Dari. Fortunately, Safia is a quick and eager learner—she now is studying at Woodlands Academy and is speaking and writing English.

Safia comes from an independent family. By this she means that her family believes in the rights of women and girls. Though poor, throughout her life, Safia has had the encouragement of her brother who wanted her to go to school. She learned many things when she attended a 2017 celebration of International Women's Day in Kabul. There were two teachers from Germany who spoke of opportunities for women and girls, and this impacted Safia greatly.

Safia later met an Afghan woman who was the founder of the Young Women's Leadership Conference, and Safia worked for this woman as her operation manager. Safia helped arrange peace-building conferences in 15 provinces of Afghanistan and faced many difficulties in the process: she was stared at and shunned by some of the people because she was presenting ideas for women and girls that challenged the status quo.

For a period of time in her life Safia experienced much loss. Her grandparents died one after the other, and then other relatives close to her also died. It was difficult. It was only through resolute determination that she was able to avoid an arranged marriage when she was 14 years old.

Social media has played prominently in Safia's life. While studying in Kabul, Safia volunteered one day a week at an orphanage called Tomorrow's Hope. She played with the children and even spent her own money, what little she had, to provide them with a Ramadan dinner. Her posts on social media told the stories of these children and invited support for the orphanage, and her efforts were successful. Donations came in.

It was also through social media that she connected with Tom Valenti, Chicago attorney and co-founder of Global Youth Development Initiative. Safia asked Tom about finding a school for her in the United States—truly a one-in-a-million-chance request. Nevertheless, after much assistance from Tom and many months of effort, she filled out the application for Woodlands Academy. She had come so far, but the cost was yet another barrier—how would that ever be possible? Safia was granted a scholarship to Woodlands, and her impossible dream became a reality! Safia is now a member of the junior class, and the school is much enriched by having this young Afghan woman learn and share alongside her Sacred Heart sisters.

Safia's great hope is to work in international relations. She wants to help the children in the Tomorrow's Hope orphanage, and she wants to help on a global scale. She has "a will of doing greater things." She will develop her talents and skills here in the U.S. and at Woodlands Academy and then return to Afghanistan to contribute to the future of the Afghan people.

About Global Youth Development Initiative

It was a program where mentors meet with mentees via Skype and phone calls that kept Safia in touch with Chicago attorney Tom Valenti. Modern technology makes it possible for Global Youth Development Initiative to create supportive one-to-one virtual mentoring relationships with students like Safia around the world. The program assists aspiring young professionals in conflict and post-conflict zones with the development of their leadership, employability, and networking skills. This is a unique and multiculturally sensitive mentoring program, and Global Youth Development Initiative facilitates the conversations and relationships necessary for these students to build strong networks and achieve their professional goals

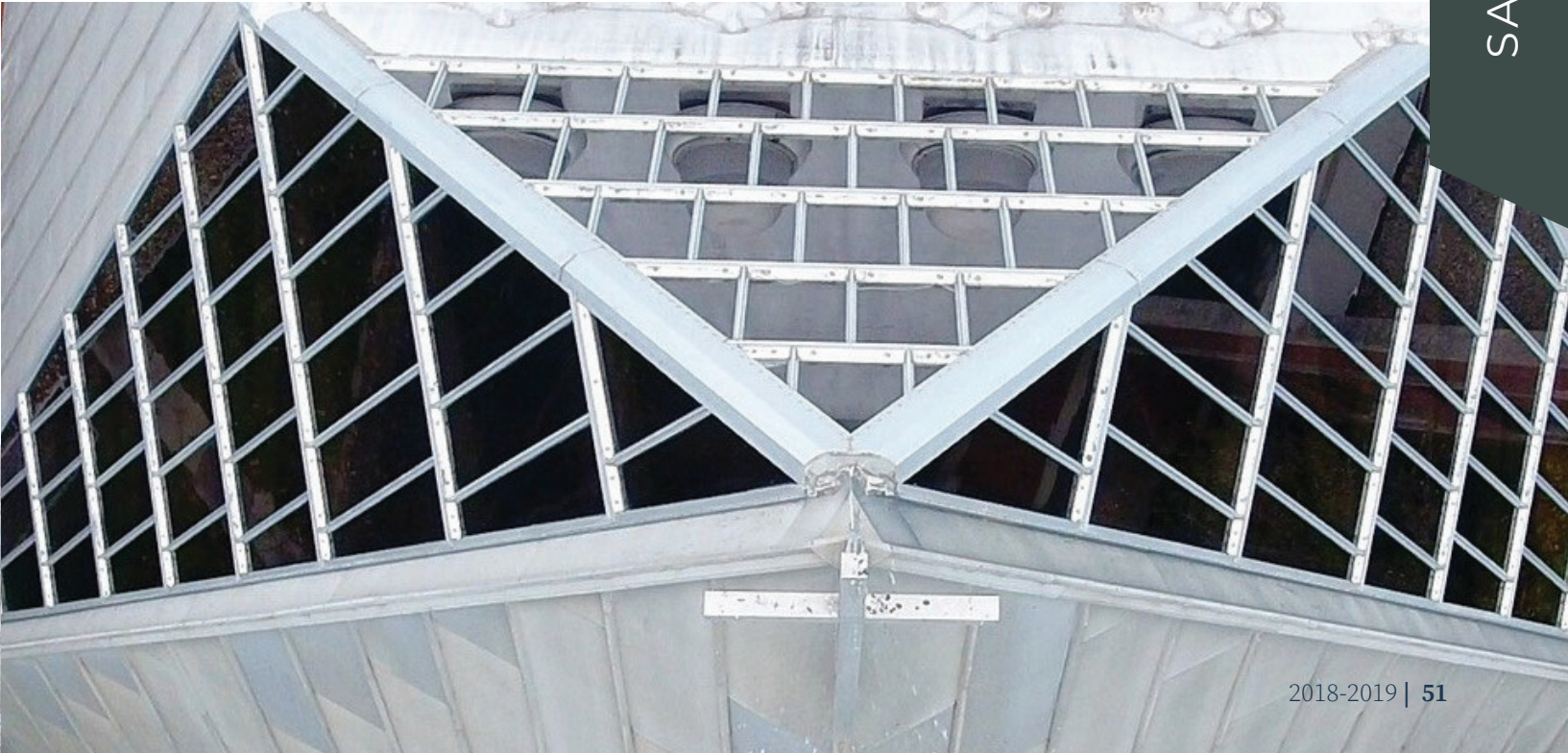

Mater Admirabilis Legacy Society

The story of Mater Admirabilis teaches us that many of the most beautiful gifts can be better appreciated after the passage of time. Many members of our community look back fondly on their years at Woodlands Academy of the Sacred Heart and commit themselves to helping Woodlands far into the future. It is because of this farsightedness that those who commit to a planned gift become members of the Mater Admirabilis
