

COVID-19 TESTING & EXPOSURE GUIDANCE

The COVID-19 Testing & Exposure Guidance document represents a "decision tree" which will guide LRCA's health staff to determine the return timeline that a student or faculty/staff member will be permitted to return to campus in the event of a possible or confirmed COVID-19 infection.

Students, faculty and staff will be evaluated and potentially sent home if ANY of the following symptoms, or other symptoms determined by the ADH to be consistent with COVID-19, are present: cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever of 100.4° or higher, chills, repeated shaking, body aches, sore throat, runny nose, new loss of taste or smell, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or pressure in chest. For symptoms consistent with COVID-19, reference testing and exposure criteria below to determine when individuals may return. People who are ill should contact their health care provider for additional guidance.
