



Welcome back to another brand new school year! Here is information regarding homeschooling within Eastern Carver County Schools.

If you are a **returning homeschool family within Eastern Carver County Schools**, please submit the following required documents:

- Submit the **“Letter of Intent to Continue to Provide Instruction”** (Due October 1<sup>st</sup>). You may use this form supplied on-line or submit your own form or letter of intent.

If you are **new to homeschooling within Eastern Carver County Schools**, please submit the following required documents:

- Please fill out the **“Nonpublic School, Including Homeschools Full Report”**. (Due October 1<sup>st</sup>) This form is only required the first year you decide to home school your student(s) (ages 7–17).

The following forms are **required for all homeschool families** within Eastern Carver County Schools.

- Immunization Reporting is required when you first submit the full report or when your child reaches seventh grade (age 12). You can use this form **“Pupil Immunization Record”** form or submit immunization records from your physician.
- You are **required** to give your student(s) a nationally norm-referenced standardized achievement test (MN Statute 120A.22). We have put a link regarding ordering tests from MSTP (**MSTP Testing**) on our website if you choose to use this service.

The following forms are **optional** for all homeschool families:

- If you wish to get reimbursed for textbooks/tests, please fill out the **“Student Report for Aids to Nonpublic Students”** form and submit by the **October 1<sup>st</sup> deadline**. If this document is not received, we are unable to reimburse for any purchases. Please remember all items become the property of Eastern Carver County Schools. Please see the Homeschool Ordering/Reimbursement Process and Procedures information on the website for further information.
- If you wish to apply for Free and Reduced lunches, please fill out the **“Application for Educational Benefits”** and submit along with your home school documents.
- If you have a student with special needs or have concerns, please be advised that we are available to assist you. Please see Special Education Services information letter.
