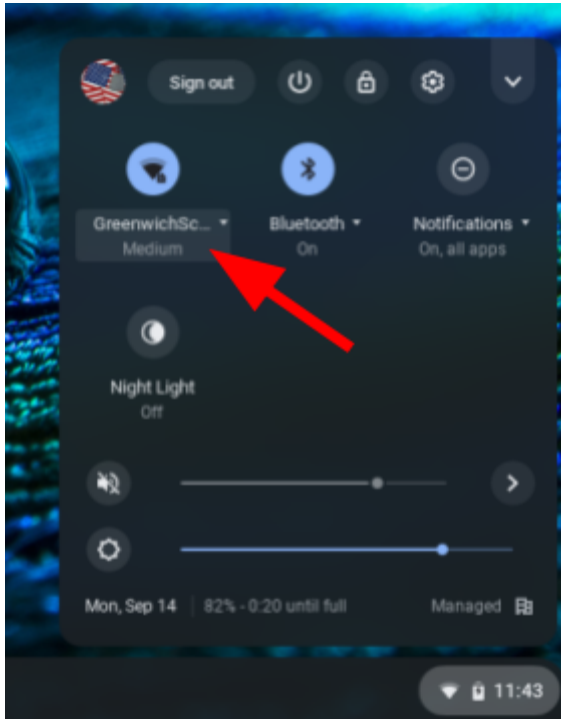


How to find the MAC ID on a Chromebook

If you are currently connected to the internet

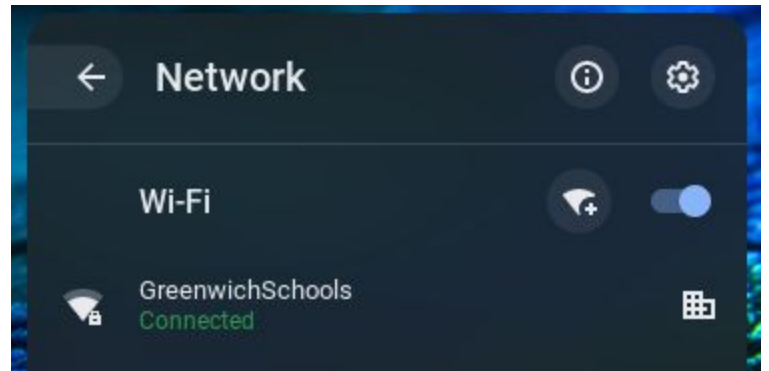
(if not connected see below)



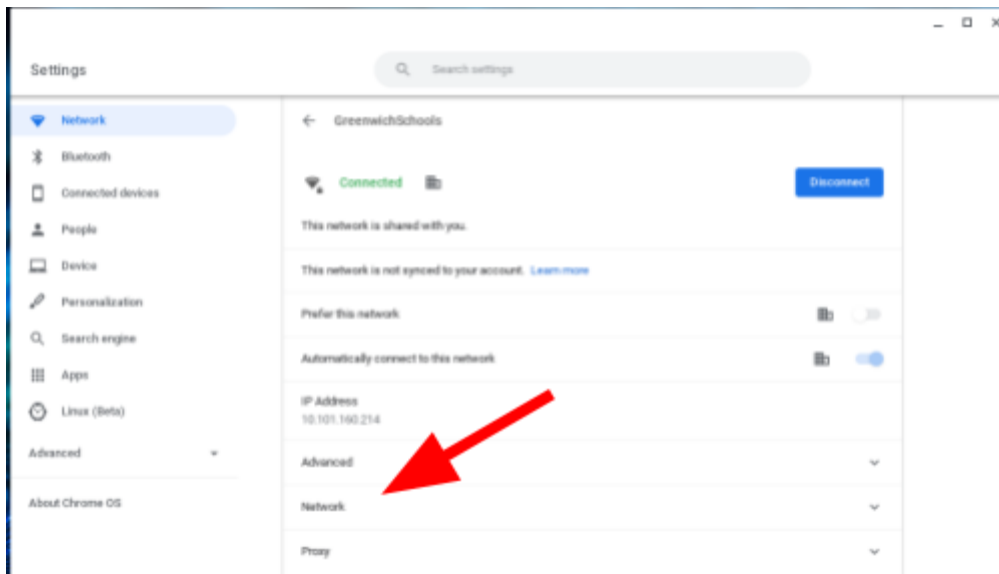
Click on the time at the bottom-right of the screen.

Click on the name of your current WiFi connection.

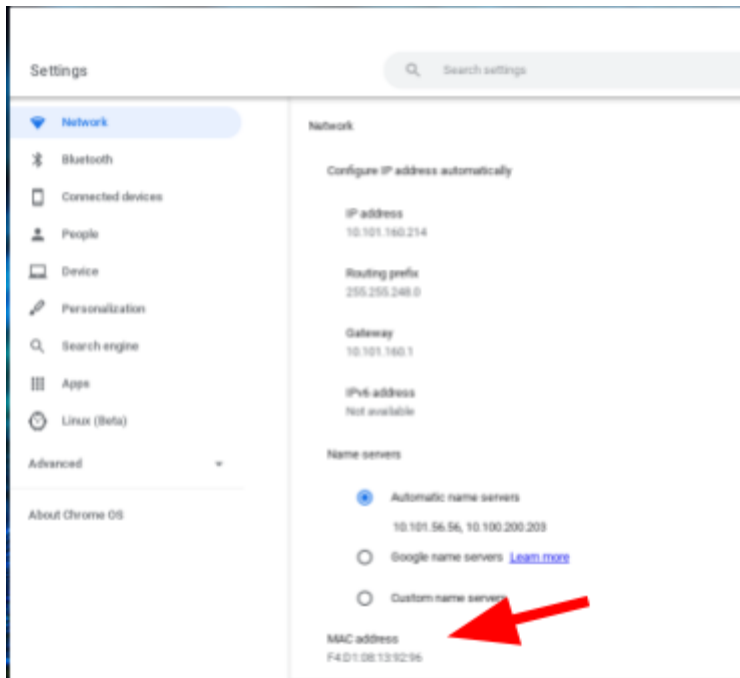
Click on the name of your current WiFi connection, again. This will open a settings window.



On the right of the window you will see details of your network connection. In the lower part you will see Advanced, Network, and Proxy.

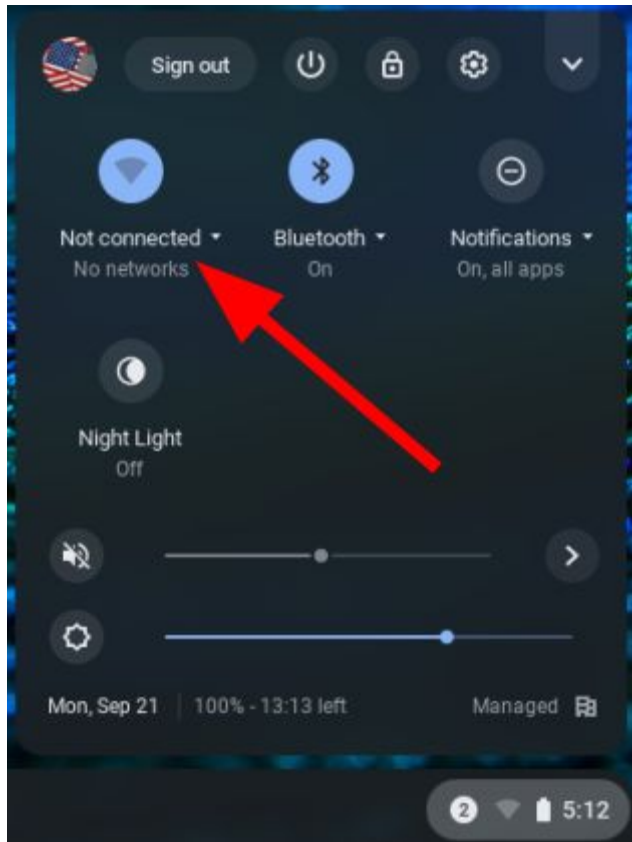


Click on Network, then scroll all the way down to the bottom where you will see your devices' MAC ID (also called MAC Address).



The MAC ID is six pairs of characters separated by colons. It can be a combination of letters and numbers. The MAC ID shown above is F4:D1:08:13:92:96. Your's will be different.

If you are NOT currently connected to the internet



Click on the time in the bottom-right of the screen.

Click on the WiFi icon (where it says "Not connected")

Click on the info icon (the letter 'i' in a circle) and your MAC ID will pop up.
