



COVID-19 Case Notification

September 22, 2020

Dear FPS Parents, Guardians, and Staff;

This is to notify you that an individual enrolled at Fairfield Ludlowe High School has tested positive for COVID-19. This individual has **not** been in the building in the past 72 hours and has **not** been in close contact with anyone in the school community in the two days prior to testing.

Therefore, there's no need for anyone at FLHS to self-quarantine and school will remain open.

If there was a need for anyone to self-quarantine, they would be contacted directly by a member of the Fairfield Health Department Contact Tracing Team.

CDC and Connecticut Department of Public Health protocols require that anyone testing positive remain in isolation for at least 10 days. Information related to case investigations is confidential and private health information will not be disclosed by FPS or Fairfield Health Department. Health and safety protocols were followed in consultation with Sands Cleary, Director of the Fairfield Health Department and Jill Mitchell RN, Nursing Supervisor.

The safety of our community is our priority. We are monitoring this situation closely and will continue to keep you informed of any changes or additional information.

Important Definitions:



Case: Individual who tests positive for SARS-CoV-2 by laboratory-confirmed PCR or Antigen Test.



Contact: A person exposed to a Case; i.e., spend 15 minutes or more within six feet of a Case.



School setting: classroom, other interior school location, bus stop, bus or other form of transportation, school grounds, or school-related event held at other locations.
