Purpose	Tuition covers 88% of the yearly operating budget and is the School's primary source of income. To keep tuition rises at a minmium, the budget is supplemented by various giving intiatives throughout the year.	Every year Lamplighter Fund gifts provide direct funding for educational initiatives and operational enhancements that tuition alone does not cover. Lamplighter Fund is the School's highest fundraising priority and 100% parent participation is always the goal!	Auction serves as the Lamplighter Parents' Association's largest fundraiser and community builder of the year with numerous volunteer opportunities.	Endowment gifts are held and invested by the School. A portion of investment income is drawn annually to support specific programs.	Tribute gifts are given to honor or recognize friends, children, family members, or teachers.	LPA dues and the Spirit Store fund the community building activities of the LPA such as grade level activities, cultural awareness, community outreach, and faculty and staff appreciation efforts.	A planned gift is any gift that a donor includes in their estate planning. It often allows the donor to keep more of what they have earned through their lifetime, but allows a far greater gift to Lamplighter in the future. All donors who make a bequest to Lamplighter will be included in the Founders Legacy Society.

Pledges must be received by May 31 to be included in the Annual Report.	Auction is coordinated annually by parent volunteers. Spirit Store merchandise is coordinated annually by parent volunteers and is open online from mid-August through May 31. A pop-up shop is held periodically throughout the year. Named endowment opportunities are also available.	Tribute gifts can be designated to Lamplighter Fund, the Erik Jonsson Media Center, or any existing restricted or endowed fund.	LPA dues and Spirit Store proceeds fund the LPA operating budget and provide community building activities throughout the year. The Spirit Store includes all spirit wear merchandise and is also a platform for ticket sales and other LPA initiatives.
