Dear Assignors,

1. All officials will park in grass area on the side of the tennis court area.
2. Upon the official's arrival at the facility, all officials will be screened and temperature checked by a member of the athletic department staff.
3. Officials will not have access to the locker room/changing area.
4. We will require a COVID notice form to be signed. We will send this to all officials a few days before their assigned game.
5. Officials are responsible to provide their own water bottles and towel. These items should be labeled with each individuals' name on them and should not be shared with anyone. If a refill is needed, we can accommodate your request. Water bottles and cups will not be available.
6. Touchless hand sanitizers will be provided at 6 locations around the field area in Coach McNelly Stadium. One in each corner off the field in lane 3 of the track and one behind each bench on the track at the 50 yard line.
