Rogersville City School Medicine Policy

- All medications must be delivered to the school clinic in person by the parent / guardian of the student of the parent's adult designee.
- <u>NEVER</u> SEND MEDICINE OF ANY TYPE TO SCHOOL WITH YOUR CHILD!
- In the event medication is sent to school by a child, the medication will NOT be dispensed unless a parent / guardian / parent's designee comes to school to verify and sign for the medication with school personnel.
- ALL prescription medication must be brought to school in the original, pharmacy labeled container. Please no mixing of medications in the same bottle. (You may want to ask your pharmacist to give you're an extra bottle with a label on it, one for home and one for the school clinic).
- It is recommended that all nonprescription (over the counter) medication (example: Tylenol) be brought to school in an unopened and sealed manufacturer's original container and label, with the ingredients listed and the student's name affixed to the container. <u>NO</u> Ziploc bags / baggies, unlabeled bottles, or expired medications will be accepted!
- All unused medication will only be returned to the parent / guardian / parent's adult designee. No medication will be stored over the summer; medications left at the end of the school year will be discarded before the summer break begins.
