Last year's transition to online from on person was difficult, but we did make a good amount of money. There is the possibility to do silent auction again this year, but we would prefer not to have to change venues from in person to online at the last minute. The auction made \$4,000 last year. The executive board's concern is that donations primarily come from classroom funds (which we aren't collecting this year), parent

donations and small business donations. We know that people are hurting this year and donations may not be available to us.
