

## **Important Information From the Assistant Principal**

Yesterday ended schedule changes and Hybrid/Remote option. The hybrid/remote option remains in effect until November 6 at which time you may request a change. If a student is on the remote learner list, and comes in, he or she will be sent home. Students may not come in once they commit to remote. It is necessary to keep class sizes safe.

- **Purple (Day 1)** Freshmen A-L, Sophomores A-K, Juniors A-I and Seniors A-L
- **Gold (Day 2)** Freshmen M-Z, Sophomores L-Z, Juniors L-Z and Seniors M-Z
- Remote students who log in after the first 5 minutes of class, will not be admitted. It is very disruptive to admit late students.
- Remote learners are subject to the same rules in our Handbook and in classroom decorum.
- Remote learners should be coming in to pick up textbooks this week. Teachers will be assigning coursework and homework from the textbooks.
- Students must set up a **g suite email account**. Directions were sent last week. Without a Loughlin email by this Friday, students will be closed out of PlusPortal. The email is necessary for curbing Zoom bombing and it will be necessary for the Ipad.
