

# Community College Applications

Most community college applications in Washington State are free and usually only take about fifteen minutes to fill out. Seniors probably want to start the process in March. Once you have your application completed it is recommended you go on that community college's website under freshman applications and follow their directions for your next steps. Some community colleges are still requiring you take the Accuplacer as a placement test while others have gone away from that due to the Corona Virus restrictions. Most community colleges are also now substituting the state SBAC scores or grades from senior English and Math classes as tools for placement in college level classes. Once you have completed your application and necessary follow up steps you will be contacted to attend an orientation where you will be assigned an advisor to help plan your community college classes. Most community colleges also offer some great scholarships that you can apply for once you have completed your application. I am including the admissions websites for both TCC and Olympic CC for specific details for each school. If you are going to apply to any other community college just go to their website for specific application details.
