

Four Year College Applications

When applying to four year colleges one of the most important things to pay attention to is each school's application deadline as they differ from school to school. You should complete the FAFSA as soon as you can after October 1st so that each school you are applying to will receive your FAFSA application and will be able to process it once you are accepted. There are many factors to consider when trying to figure out what college will be the right fit for you. Some of the things to consider are cost, how difficult the school is to get into, size, location, majors offered, in state or out of state, on and off campus living options, internships offered and job placement statistics, clubs and activities on campus, etc.

Once you have decided what schools you want to apply to you will want to get on each school's website and apply probably starting with the school that has the earliest deadline. Once you have applied to one school it is recommended that you print out that application before sending it as most college applications are going to ask for 90% of the same information.
