Please review the adjusted times for the Drop-Off and Pick-up lines.



We ask that everyone be courteous and follow the guidelines below

- * Have students **prepared to exit** your vehicle.
- * Say good-byes beforehand.
- * Students should have their mask on when staff approach the car and be ready to exit.
- * Student should be on the passenger side of the car.
- * Students should be able to unbuckle by themselves.
- * Student should be able to open the door and climb out.
- * Please do not pass other parents in the car line.
- * Please drop students at designated drop-off areas. (see map below)

crafts.



FOOD ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE

The USDA has generously provided funding which allows the West Bloomfield School District to provide meals free of charge until December 31 or until funds expire to any child 18 or under or persons up to age 26 who are enrolled in an educational program that is recognized by a state or local public educational agency. Each child is eligible to receive seven breakfast and lunch meals each week.

The meal options for Gretchko families are take-home meals curbside pick-up of 7 breakfast and lunch meals at Roosevelt Elementary or West Bloomfield High School on Wednesdays. TECHNOLOGY INFORMATION

West West Bloomfield School District issued each student a new computer for educational access. It is essential that students use the computers issued for their classwork and zoom meetings. Updates and software changes are pushed to the district computers, and students not using district issued computers may not have access to the same information and programming.

Please monitor your children on the computer especially during zoom classes and meetings. We often see other individuals in the audience. Please help teachers by monitoring background noise and other interruptions of "non" class happenings.

Sometimes families forget that the computers the children are learning from, also have cameras that share whatever is in the background of the computer screen. Also, if there are conversations happening in the area, the voices and conversations are shared throughout the rest of the class. Please teach your student how and why we use the mute button.

Please join our "Special's teachers" zoom meetings through the Special's Teachers Canvas page. If you are having difficulty getting onto your Specials zoom, please follow the directions below.

- * After you click on the Specials Teacher's zoom link, close the pop up box.
- * Log in with your child's gmail account.
- * If the zoom says "connecting" please go back to the teacher's link.
- * Start again.
- * Your child's name should appear to log into zoom.
- * It should now allow you to enter the meeting.

Please return this to your school office as soon as possible, or email it to kathernesheiko@hotmail.com. The first backpack of food will be sent home the first week of October. If your child is in enrolled in Lakers On Line, you can pick up your child's bag at WBHS from 6:30-7:30 am, 11:30 am-12:30 pm or from 4:00-5:00 pm on Wednesday of each week.

DAILY ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

Daily Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

Please refer to the map of the school to see where your students' class is located. We will have three arrival/dismissal locations this year:

- 1.) On the West /left side of the school Ayar, Wild, Sizemore,
- Pace, Allen, Hans, Williams, Pawlaczyk, Costello
- 2.) At the North/back end of the school Cloud Care
- 3.) On the **East/right** side of the school Smith, Barker, Geottes/Kirk, Reed, Risden
 - All cars enter the left (West) circle.
 - Remain in the car line through drop-offs 1, 2, 3.

- Drop your student at their designated drop off location (see above).
- · All parents and students remain in vehicles.
- Students unhook their seat belt and open car doors to exit the car.
- Students will be assisted by staff when exiting or entering vehicles.
- Teachers will be present to greet and direct students.
- Students will wait outside with their teacher until others arrive.
- All cars continue following the car line through all drop off areas.
- Follow the car line around the building.
- · Loop around at station 3 to exit.
- Exit the same way you enter through the West circle.
- Please follow arrows and directions from our staff.
