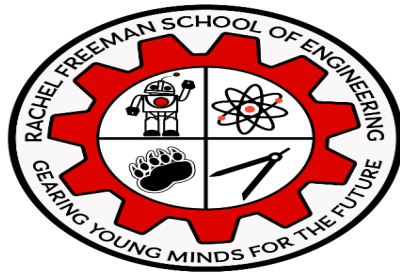

Dear Parent/Guardian,

As part of the Read to Achieve law (G.S. §115C-83.1) passed by the General Assembly in 2012, your child will take the Beginning-of-Grade 3 (BOG3) Reading Test to establish a baseline measure of beginning third-grade reading skills. This test will be administered on the following dates:

October 20th for students in AA (Monday –Tuesday Group)
October 23rd for students in BB (Thursday-Friday Group)

The majority of beginning third-grade students are not expected to demonstrate third-grade reading proficiency (score an achievement level 3, 4, or 5) on the BOG3 Test because they have received very little third-grade reading instruction. Following the BOG3 Test administration, you will receive an individual student report with your child's score. At the end of the school year, your child will take the End of Grade 3 Reading Test (EOG) to measure growth from the BOG3.

State required tests must be administered face to face. Students receiving **only** remote or virtual learning will need to come to the school building for the BOG3 administration. We are scheduling test days for these students on **October 28th**. Please plan to have your child here for the administration of the BOG3. The test is approximately 90 minutes long, but if needed, your child could test for up to 180 minutes.
