Get into your spaceship and hold on tight as you fly to the moon. When you get there, explore the moon by finding different ways to travel around it. How will you travel? Can you explore by jumping forwards, backwards and from side to side? Can you think of different ways to travel? Remember — Use your eyes to be aware of the space around you, so you don't bump into anything. When jumping, land with knees bent and both legs glued together.	Physical Activity
