

ABSENCES

Athe beginning of next week, you will receive a specific Attendance email from our communication system. This email will be child-specific (families with multiple CDL students will receive multiple emails) and include the link to our new daily attendance form. This form will allow for a more streamlined method for student absence tracking as well as a location for parents to upload any necessary forms such as a doctor's excuse. Please make sure that all necessary PowerSchool information has been updated as this email will go to the first listed email address in PowerSchool for parent-guardian one and parent-guardian two. If you do not receive this email, be sure to check your spam folder as these tend to end up there. It is also important to save this link since it will be the preferred method for reporting a CDL absence however, we understand that you may need to use the old form so that has been linked here.

IMMUNIZATION REMINDERS

Kindergaren, 7th grade and 12th grade students are required to turn in student shot records to your child's assigned school. An email reminder was sent to CDL families regarding Olentangy Schools immunization requirements yesterday. This is essential to remain enrolled in Olentangy Schools. The deadline for immunization records is October 2, 2020 (Grades K and &) and October 15, 2020 (Grade 12). SCHOOL FEES

School fees are used for student supplies. In a physical setting, the uses may include something like a workbook, a novel, clay for art class, or a subscription to a classroom periodical. In Committed Distance Learning, these fees may be used for any of the items listed, or something like a digital subscription to an app or website.

CDL school supply purchases are being made now. High school teachers are currently sharing information regarding the distribution of physical materials. Once school supplies are finalized for the elementary and middle school levels, teachers will communicate if any physical materials require picked up.
