Su estudiante está asignado al grupo en el otro lado de este papel. El primer día de instrucción en persona para este grupo también está en el otro lado. La rotación del Plan B de NHCS incluirá ir a la escuela durante dos días y hacer el aprendizaje remoto los otros tres días de la semana. (Lunes-A, Martes-A, **Miércoles- remoto**, Jueves-B, Viernes-B) Si prefiere que su hijo participe solamente en el aprendizaje remoto y **no** vaya a la escuela, complete la encuesta enviada por correo electrónico o acceda a la encuesta en el sitio web de nuestra escuela.

No podemos realizar ninguna "reasignación de grupo" adicional en este momento. La única excepción sería para poner hermanos(as) en el mismo grupo. Ha habido mucho tiempo y esfuerzo en hacer los grupos para mantener nuestros alumnos y el personal de la escuela lo más seguros posible.

Mientras estén en la escuela, los estudiantes deberán usar una mascarilla cuando estén en el edificio y también en el autobús. Tendremos unos breves descansos de las mascarillas durante el día y también durante el desayuno y el almuerzo, pero los estudiantes tendrán que usar sus mascarillas en cualquier otro momento durante el día. Además, antes de que su hijo entre en el edificio, será examinado, lo que incluirá un chequeo de la temperatura junto con una serie de preguntas de un miembro del personal de la escuela.

Para evitar la propagación de los gérmenes, le pedimos a cada estudiante que tenga sus propios suministros escolares durante sus días en la escuela. Los estudiantes ya no tendrán acceso a los casilleros, lo que ayudará a mantener la limpieza del edificio y también evitará la congregación de los estudiantes en los pasillos. Los suministros escolares recomendados son:

- Una mochila personal
- Una botella de agua personal
- 4 cuadernos
- 1 carpeta
- Lápices y lápices de color
- 2 marcadores de pizarra
- Una mascarilla adicional en una bolsa Ziplock en la mochila
