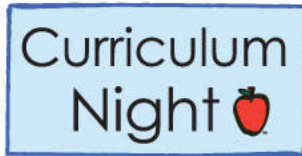

FALL OPPORTUNITIES in MN

Whether searching for activities weeks in advance or an hour in advance, make use of the Fall Color Finder, a trip-planning tool on the Department of Natural Resources webpage (www.mndnr.gov/fallcolor) that shows the progression of fall color across Minnesota. For mobile device users, the DNR offers fall colors “to go” on a mobile Fall Color Finder that is integrated with Google maps.
