7. Coronavirus - Showed the committee the John Hopkins live tracker of where the COVID-19 virus has been confirmed as well as deaths associated with the virus. Mr. Kreiter updated the committee on the information that the District has given out to parents as well. He also let the committee know what measures the District is taking to keep schools and buses disinfected. The committee then discussed ideas of things the District could do if confirmed cases appear in the Houston area.
8. Communication Scenario, Safety Concern, Safety Idea - Mr. Kreiter asked the committee to write a communication release for a fake scenario, the committee shared their statements. He also asked the committee to bring a safety concern or safety idea with them. Several shared their concerns and ideas such as visitor management, secondary

deliveries, students with custody concerns (intricate decrees), additional cameras and the see something say something responses.
