President's report Cambra stated she will do a video for open house. PTO's goal is to still do all the activities we normally do. College and Career Fair will be tricky. An email was sent to all parents via list serve regarding membership. We have things "for sale" via paypal.

Treasurer's report Susan went over the proposed budget and it was revised. Meryl made a motion to approve the revisions to the budget. Anjeanette seconded the motion. Revisions were approved.
