














Results

- 82% retention rate

- Loan default rate only 2.2%


Job placement

- What?
 - High school transcript
 - ACT/SAT optional for Fall 2021 applicants
 - 3. Letter of recommendation, personal statement, resume (recommended)
- 2-4 weeks
- Average ACT: 25/SAT: 1200; Average GPA: 3.5
