To apply to Corban University, you must:

- Be a Bible-believing Christian wanting to grow in your relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Complete and submit the following items:
 1. Application (www.corban.edu)
 2. Personal Faith Statement (*in application*)
 3. SAT (*min. 990*), ACT (*min. 19*), or CLT (*min. 64*) scores OR academic reference OR personal essay
 4. Cumulative, unweighted high school GPA (*min. 2.7*)
 5. Official college transcripts (*if applicable*)
