Drive-Through Flu Clinic Frequently Asked Questions

Which health insurance plans do you accept? We accept the following health insurance plans:

- Aetna
- Blue Cross Blue Shield
- Cigna
- Tricare West
- Premera Blue Cross
- First Choice
- Kaiser Permanente
- Regence Blue Shield (including Healthcare Management Administrators and Regence Group Administrators)
- United Healthcare
- Medicare
- Medicaid/Apple Health plans (Coordinated Care, Community Health Plan, Molina, United Community Plan, and Amerigroup).

Do I need to have insurance? What is the out of pocket cost?

You do not need to have insurance to participate. For uninsured participants, we have a grant from King County that will cover the full cost of your immunization. If you do have insurance, please provide that information during registration. There will never be a cost to a patient to receive a flu shot, with or without insurance.

Which vaccines do you provide?

We provide the standard Quadrivalent (four strain) vaccine. The nurses carry a small amount of Thimerosal-Free (preservative free) vaccine which we offer to those who are pregnant. SVNA does not offer the high dose vaccine for those over 65 years old, flu mist (nasal spray), or pneumonia vaccine.

How do I make an appointment? To register, please visit

You can register by clicking the 'Make an Appointment' button on our home webpage (www.seattlevna.com) or by visiting our scheduling link <u>here</u>. When signing up you will select a 15-minute time slot in which to receive your immunization. We encourage you arrive at the beginning of your allotted window.

Are there any age restrictions?

SVNA can provide influenza vaccinations to participants ages four years old and older. For children 17 years old and younger, the parent or legal guardian must provide their consent via an electronic signature when registering.

What Happens if I miss my appointment? Can I reschedule or cancel?

If you cannot make your appointment, or miss your appointment, please cancel, or reschedule via the confirmation email sent at the time of registration.

What do I need to have with me for my appointment?

Please bring your current insurance card, if applicable. Wear short-sleeved clothing on the day of your appointment and remember that face coverings will be required to participate in the clinic.

Can I bring family members or other people with me for my appointment?

Yes, family/household members are welcome to attend. You can bring family members or other participants in your car, but please schedule them in the same time slot if possible. Each family member needs their own registration in the patient's name. So, a family of four will need four separate registrations. If a time slot fills up before all family members can register, please register the remaining family members in the nearest available slot. All family members can all still come to the clinic at the same time
