Updates for students in grades pre-K through 5th:

- Reading MAP testing for students in kindergarten through 3rd grade starts today! Reading teachers should have already reached out to you about testing and shared updates in their Canvas course. Some 4th and 5th grade students who need to complete MAP testing will receive details from their reading teacher via email in the next two weeks. A parent or other adult will need to be present to support students with logging into the MAP test, but should not help students on the test itself. If you have any questions about MAP testing or if a student will need assistance logging in, please contact your student's reading teacher.
- The deadline to submit your application for the Free and Reduced Lunch program is THIS Thursday, Oct. 1. Participation in the program offers more benefits than just meals. Submitting your application can mean increased Title I funding for your school, access to fee waivers, and eligibility for some grant programs!
