I have had the pleasure of connecting with many of you, and I want to make sure that you know how to get in touch with the Tulsa Virtual Academy team if you need help with anything. Your advisory teacher is your first line of contact and will be able to answer many questions that you might have. Teachers' office hours should be posted in their Canvas course; these times are available for you to use to connect with them. We also have school leaders assigned to the different grade levels that are able to assist. Updates for students in grades 6th through 12th:

- In order to help students plan, teachers will begin assigning topics to their Zoom calls that are held on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. This will help students ensure that they know when certain topics will be covered. You'll find the schedule and topics in each teacher's Canvas course. Zoom meetings will continue to be recorded for students to view later if they miss the live session.
- Parents will soon be able to follow along with their student's progress and assignments with observer accounts in Edmentum. Edmentum's [Sensei for Families](#) portal will provide you with progress reports, grades, and lists of assignments and deadline. You will receive an invitation to sign up for Sensei for Families this week and will then be able to create an account.
- [Exact Path](#) is a free resource that supports learners at individual levels. Your student's advisory teacher will share details about the Exact Path diagnostic tests that are available for students to complete on their own time. These tests show where students have gaps in learning and help to create a plan for them to work on areas that need improvement. If you have questions about Exact Path, please contact your student's advisory teacher.
- The deadline to submit your application for the Free and Reduced Lunch program is THIS Thursday, Oct. 1. Participation in the program offers more benefits than just meals. Submitting your application can mean increased Title I funding for your school as well as free registration for the SAT/ACT and waived college application fees!
