The Daniels Scholarship Program: The Daniels Scholarship Program offers a comprehensive, four-year college scholarship that provides financial and personal support focused on helping Daniels Scholars succeed in college, and in life. Must be a high school senior graduating from a school in Colorado, New Mexico, **Utah**, or Wyoming. Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and a minimum ACT score of 18. The applicant's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must have an Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of \$85,000 or less on the 2019 Form 1040 U.S. Individual Income Tax Return on which the applicant appears as a dependent.
