In-Person After School

Class Procedures

- Instructors and students will wear face coverings at all times.
- Activities held in classrooms will be limited to 10 people.
- Social distancing will be practiced.
- Tables/desks/equipment will be set up to achieve proper social distancing and face the same direction.
- Classes are scheduled to be spread out in buildings to social distance participants.
- Students will have their own set of supplies to use for each class. Supplies will be disinfected before and after each use.
- Instructors will manage social distancing throughout the class.
- Students will wash hands before entering class each day, after restroom breaks, before snack breaks and before dismissal, at a minimum.
- If a student becomes ill during class time, they will be moved to an isolated area and parent/guardian will be contacted for immediate pickup.
- Students who are picked up after class will be escorted out of the main entrance of the building for curbside pick up at 4:50p. Adults are not permitted in the school for pick-up.

Registration is coordinated by District 196 Community Education. Registration for an after school class can be done two ways:

1. Register online at www.district196.org/community-ed and click on the "Registration" tab located on the upper left side of the main page. First time users will need to set up an account and add all family members who will be registering for the after school classes. To search for an after school class online, type in the course code or name. When registering, please check to make sure class location is Diamond Path Elementary. Students who enroll online receive a class confirmation email and will also receive a class confirmation sent home from school. Registering online is your best chance to get into your class of choice.
2. **Return registration form with payment to your child's classroom teacher by Monday, October 12.** Registration forms are distributed to students in their Friday folders. Students should register for a first choice and a second choice. Class sizes are limited. Submission of a registration does not guarantee placement in a class. Every effort will be made to place your child in an after school class of their choice. If your child is not placed in any after school class, you will be notified by phone. Class confirmations will be sent home from school.

Scholarships-One scholarship per student, per session is available to students on free and reduced lunch. Students on free or reduced lunch receive a 50% discount on one class fee in this brochure. If student would like to register for second class, the class fee for the second class must be paid in full.

Scholarships can be processed through the online registration, by phone or on the registration form sent home from school. If you wish to request a scholarship for an after school class when registering online, please select the second or third class fee from the drop-down fee selection. You can also fill out the appropriate information on the registration form and turn in to your child's classroom teacher or call the Community Education registrars at 651-423-7920. All requests made for scholarships are subject to verification.

Late Registrations-Register early, before the registration deadline. Registrations after the deadline may not be placed in a class due to the class being full, or insufficient amount of time to purchase class supplies or an insufficient amount of time to communicate student information to the classroom teacher, class instructor, school office staff and Community Education coordinators. Your child's safety is our top priority and late registrations can hinder our ability to communicate all the important information before the first day of class.

Health Notes-A school nurse may not always be on-site during the Community Education enrichment classes that take place before or after the school day. Please let the school nurse know if there are medications that your child will need access to during their before or after school class. Emergency medications will be given directly to the Community Education program coordinator. Emergency medications will be administered by trained school personnel when the school nurse is unavailable.

If students cannot comply with these behavior expectations before or after school, parents will be notified and a behavior incident report will be filled out by the after school coordinator or class instructor. If your child receives two or more incident reports during a session, they could be asked to be withdrawn from their class with no refund.

Inclement Weather/Other Emergencies-If District 196 schools are closed for the day, all before and after school Community Education activities are canceled. Every effort will be made to reschedule canceled classes however, there are instances where classes cannot be rescheduled. Cancellation Policies-

Full refunds will be made if your class is canceled due to low enrollment.

Cancellation requests received at least five working days before class start date qualify for a refund, less a \$10 processing fee per class and any costs incurred (supplies).

Requests received less than five working days before class start date will receive credit voucher only, less a \$10 processing fee per class and any costs incurred (supplies).

If a class is canceled due to COVID-19 before mid-point of class, you will receive a prorated credit voucher. No refunds or credits will be issued after mid-point of class.

Refunds and credit vouchers are not issued after class has begun.
