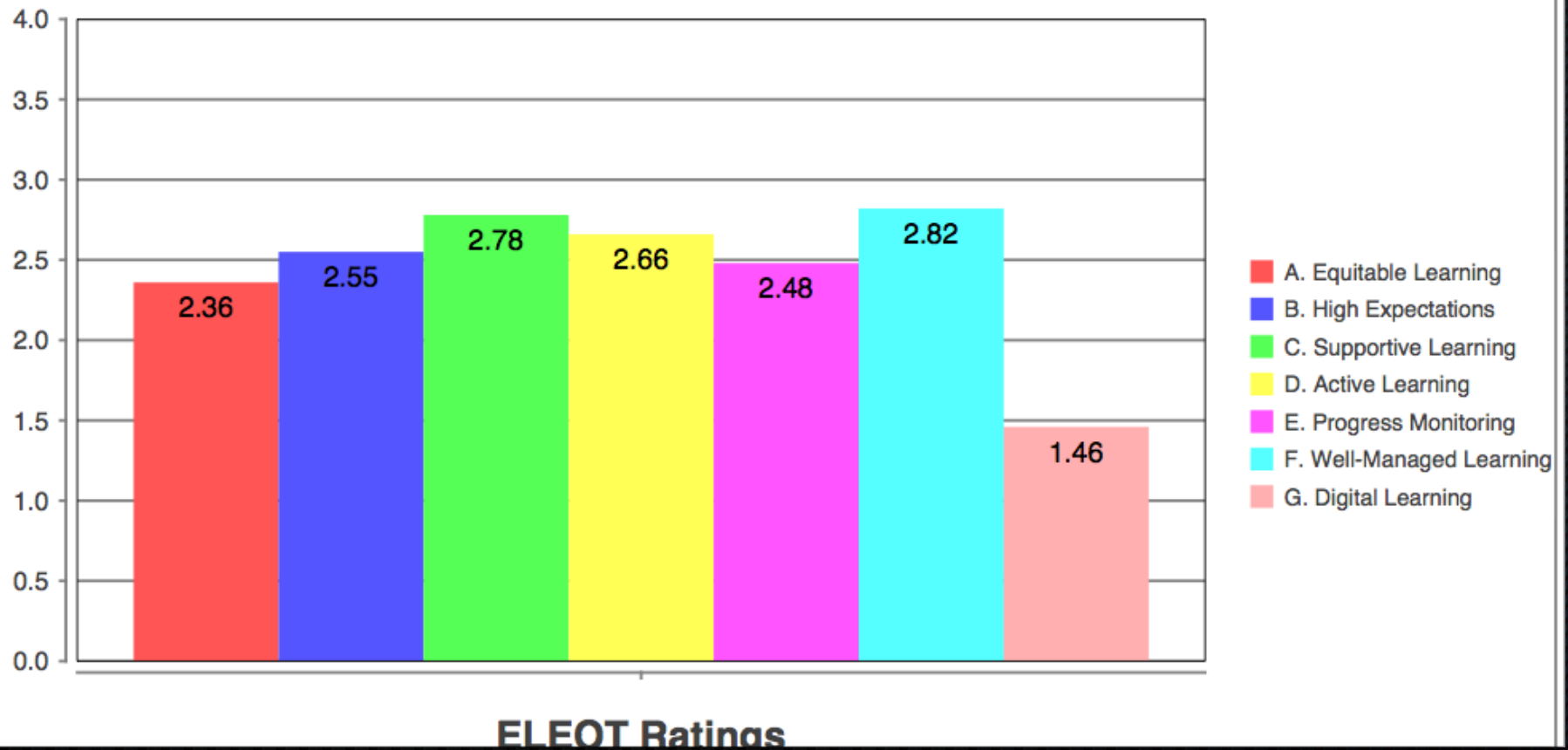

The Effective Learning Environments Observation Tool (ELEOT)

How does CRB1 improve AdvancedED ELEOT ratings?

- ✦ 1st - Build network infrastructure that is strong and flexible to last 7 to 10 years. Increase Bandwidth at all school sites
- ✦ 2nd - Purchase Networking & Server equipment that is under warranty and ensure 100% up time and configure to provide for maximum learning opportunities, security and management of resources
- ✦ 3rd - Provide constant training to our staff and provide them with the Technology Tools they need to ensure both our students' and staff members' future

Once the Gears are in Place our chain of digital learning can move at whatever speed we need it to!

- ✦ Provide a mobile learning device to every student at CRB1
- ✦ Ensure all Teachers have training on these devices see the power of efficiency
- ✦ Work with Curriculum to align Technology Tools to meet standards



The Bike (Bandwidth) Upgrades provided by the state of WYOMING

- Little Snake River Valley School - from 3MB to 20MB - to be completed by end of January 2014
- Rawlins Cooperative High School - from 3MB to 10MB - to be completed by mid March 2014
- Rawlins High School - Currently 200MB no upgrades planned for this year
- Rawlins Middle School - from 6MB to 40MB - to be completed by mid March 2014
- Rawlins Elementary School K-1 - from 3MB to 30MB - has been put back out to bid and installation scheduled for July 2014 possibly sooner
- Rawlins Elementary School 2-5 - from 4.5MB to 60MB - has been put back out to bid and installation scheduled for July 2014 possibly sooner
- Sinclair Elementary School - from 1.5MB to 10MB - to be completed by mid March 2014



What is it going to Cost to build the CRB1 Gears?

- Fiber installation for all of Rawlins & Sinclair = \$127,200.00 - Currently seeking funding from ERATE
- Battery Backup Replacement all sites = \$56,117 - Paid for and deployed already as of 1/1/14
- Server Replacement & Software upgrades all sites = \$67,358 - Awaiting funding
- LAN Equipment Replacement (Switches) = \$545,789 - Awaiting funding
- Wireless Equipment Replacement = \$177,644 - Awaiting funding
- Cabling, Racks & Materials = \$63,169 - Awaiting funding
- Labor, Engineering & Installation = \$647,167 - Awaiting funding
- Total Cost = \$1,684,444
