Assisting Lawrence Families To Find Affordable, Licensed Child Care



Are you looking for a safe place for a K-8 learner in Lawrence?

Mayor Daniel Rivera has created a \$400,000 Mayor's Scholarship Fund, allowing children subsidized access to licensed child care.

The Mayor's Scholarship Fund will be managed by The Community Group and Child Care Circuit. This program will run until December 31, 2020.

CHILDREN IN GRADES K-8 WILL BENEFIT FROM:

- Reliable and stable Internet connection
- Adult supervision to assist with remote learning
- Access to nutritious food
- Physical activity and outdoor play
- Socially distant interaction with their peers
- Qualified staff and licensed care

FAMILY ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a Lawrence resident
- Family must have at least one school age child (K-8)
- Do not currently have child care subsidy from the Department of Early Education and Care
- Priority will be given to children who are not currently enrolled in child care
- Must meet income requirements
