I understand that having a parking permit at IAA is a privilege. In order to ensure that all students in the parking lot are in a safe driving environment, I will drive in a safe and courteous manner and I will abide by all policies in the IAA Driving and Parking Lot Agreement as stated in the IAA Student Handbook. I also understand that failure to meet these expectations may result in a written parking ticket and one or more fine(s), possible towing or immobilization of my vehicle and may impact my ability to drive and park at IAA.

IAA Driving Rules and Expectations

A full description of the IAA parking policies is located in the IAA Student Handbook on the IAA website. When you sign this parking application, you are stating that you have read and agree to follow all policies and will accept all consequences for violations.

Please initial next to each statement, signifying that you have read, understand and agree to follow it:

- All student vehicles parked on campus must be parked in the designated student parking areas and have a valid annual parking permit hanging from the vehicle's rear view mirror or be registered in the office as a paid Daily Permit holder.
- **Permits may not be sold to another student. If a parking permit is lost, it must be replaced at the current price, based on the prorated schedule below. There will be no refunds for lost permits.**
- Students may never transport other students to/from school during the school day.
- Students will be courteous and respectful to other drivers, school staff, and to other vehicles and property.
- Holding a valid parking permit does not allow a student to leave school during the school day.
- Students will wear a seatbelt and ensure that all other passengers in their vehicle wear theirs also.
- Reckless driving is prohibited and may result in loss of parking privileges. Students must obey all local and state driving laws and will drive at safe speeds, according to weather conditions.
- Students will not text or use their cell phones in any way or engage in any other form of distracted driving. In the event of an accident, call 911 right away if there are injuries. In every accident, even if there is no damage to the vehicles, exchange drivers' license and insurance information with the other driver(s) and contact the CHS School Resource Officer, Dean or Chaska Police. Never drive away without stopping to speak to the other driver(s). If you hit a car that is parked, report the accident to the Purple Office staff.
- Students will not possess or use alcohol, tobacco, or any other type of illicit substances.
- Students must report changes to the Parking Applications to the office (chg in vehicle, address, etc.)
- **Vehicles should be locked and valuables should not be left in cars.** District 112 and IAA are not responsible for vandalism, injury, theft (including stolen parking permits), or damage to vehicles or items in the school parking lot.
- Vehicles found to be in continuous violation of Integrated Arts Academy Parking rules may be immobilized using a car boot. Driving a vehicle which has been immobilized may result in damage to the vehicle. District 112 and IAA are not responsible for damage caused to vehicles as a result of driving while immobilized.
