- b) TSSA budget adjustment- There is about 12,000.00 carry over from last year, we will need to figure out ideas on what to spend it on that focus on the math/language goals. Reviewed the TSSA budgets due to covid we need to allocate funds elsewhere. We will no longer have CMI and conferences we previously budgeted for. We will replace 10 sound systems and apple TVs that are older and need to be replaced. We are providing SEL and MTSS groups stipends to participate as well as teachers for working on their canvas pages.

b) Review Goals

a. Last year's goals

- i. Cook elementary will increase the number of students proficient on DIBELS composite by 12% from BOY to EOY.

Last year MOY was 6%, we were on track to hit 12% but were unable to track due to covid.

- ii. 80% of students across grades 1-4 will achieve automaticity in their math facts as measured by Reflex Math at the EOY. 80% of students 5-6 will achieve proficiency on Imagine Math benchmarks.

Due to covid not enough students used the program and we were unable to gather the data.

b. This year's goals

- i. Math Goal: Cook elementary will increase student mean growth in math as measured by performance on the CRT/RISE assessments by 5% from a MGP of 39 2018-19 school year to a MGP of 44 in the 2020-21 school year. (We will be looking at how to adjust this goal.)
- ii. ELA Goal: Cook Elementary will increase the number of students proficient on Acadience testing composite score by 10% by BOY to MOY during the 2020-21 school year.
- iii. SEL Goal: Build foundational knowledge and capacity for faculty and staff in the five CASEL competencies of self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship skills, and responsible decision-making adults by creating a school SEL plan using the Davis School District's SEL Walkthrough Tool.
