

About Davis HS Community Council Elections:

Individuals wishing to run for open positions should submit the School Community Council **Nomination Form** (see page 2) to Principal Gregory Wilkey Wilkey (gwilkey@dsdmail.net) by (April 15th of each school year)

An election, if needed, will be held via **myDSD voting system** during the following voting window:

Voting Open: (Two weeks in early May each school year)

***To access myDSD voting system,** Davis HS parents/guardians will go to myDSD and log on with guardian credentials. Parents/guardians will see notification of documents needing attention (see example below). A voting parent/guardian may change their vote at any time during the voting window but will only be allowed one vote. The myDSD voting system is anonymous and secure. Guardian accounts should be kept secure and private. Violation of voting procedures may disqualify a parent/guardian's vote or invalidate an election, or both.

What is a School Community Council?

A School Community Council is an advisory committee with communication connections between school and community. The School Community Council helps assist in the development of school improvement plans/goals and provides feedback on how the School Community Trust Land money should be appropriated. Last year Davis High School received more than **\$250,000** of Trust Lands money that was used in various ways to improve the instruction and education of our students. The council may also advise and make recommendations on school programs and school policy, and provides helpful feedback to administration and faculty on the overall functioning of the school.

Who is on the School Community Council?

The Council consists of members of the faculty, administration, and parents from the community. Members of the Council must have a student attending Davis High School and serve a two-year term. We strive to have at least one representative on the Council from each of the feeder junior high schools (Kaysville, Shoreline, and Fairfield Junior High Schools). There will be 3 vacancies for parent members on the Council for the term that will begin in the Fall of 2021.

Applications for the vacancies are being accepted via e-mail and in the Davis HS Main Office in April of each school year
