- V. Reports of Standing Committees for School Improvement
  - A. Trust Lands: Budget vs. Expenses
    - a. **Review SIP Goals.**
      1. Increase the % of K-3 students scoring at or above Acadience Reading beginning of the year composite score benchmark by 12% on end of the year benchmark assessment.
      2. Teachers will implement the professional learning community (PLC) process frequently (at least weekly) meeting with grade level team members to discuss students' achievement data, drive instruction, and develop common assessments.
      3. Improve SEL skills implementing SEL direct instruction and SEL instructional strategies.
    - b. Budget: \$64,613 for this year, rollover \$9,801 = \$74,414 total
      1. Predicted expenditure: \$78,466.49 – this will be supplemented with TSSA to cover deficit.
      2. Bulk of expenditure is salaries for reading tutors and classroom TA's that will also be trained in reading intervention strategies.
  - B. Reading Improvement – Teacher assistants and Acadience Reading
  - C. Digital Citizenship – Yearly – Will do in the future.
