The Village School of Naples began as The Caring Place Preschool in 1985 as an outreach at North Naples United Methodist Church. In 2000, the K-5 elementary school was added onto the preschool. The Middle School was established in 2009 with a STEAM focused curriculum. In 2016, TVS welcomed its first Upper School students who graduated in 2020 with 100% college acceptance.

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COVID- 19

TVS began school wide distance learning in March 2020. The transition went smoothly with teachers maintaining the high level of instruction to which students were accustomed. In-person classes resumed in August for the 2020-2021 school year with significant safety protocols in place. TVS still offers synchronous and asynchronous learning to students weekly per their needs.
