Dear ISK Community,

Greetings to all and thank you for your patience as ISK has continued to work towards a safe reopening of campus in hybrid mode. As you are likely aware, the Ministry of Education announced today that basic education institutions can begin with a couple of grades starting next week.

As mentioned in last week's Link Lite, the soonest ISK would start teaching and learning in-person on campus in hybrid mode would be October 26th, right after the October Break. With the MoE announcement that certain grades are now allowed to begin, we will start with a few grades attending school on campus right after October Break, including our examination class, Grade 12. It is important to note that ISK has already completed the MoH/MoE preparedness protocol and a site visit last week. More information about which grade levels will start on October 26th will be communicated at the end of this week along with our updated Blueprint for Reopening.

Stay tuned, and we will keep you updated as we learn more information and finalize details for reopening campus based upon what is permitted and safe. Also, don't forget the upcoming Director's Tea scheduled for October 13th at 4:00 p.m. Be well and stay healthy. We are all looking forward to seeing students on campus in the near future.
