



District Notification of Positive COVID-19 Case

October 6, 2020 Update 1:30 PM

Dear FPS Parents, Guardians, and Staff;

This is to notify you that another individual at Fairfield Ludlowe High School has tested positive for COVID-19. This individual was already in quarantine and has **not** been in the building since September 29th. There is no need for anyone else at FLHS to self-quarantine and school will remain open.

We have also been informed that an individual enrolled in our Remote Learning Academy has tested positive. This individual has **not** been in contact with anyone in the school community and no physical location is impacted.

If there was a need for anyone to self-quarantine, they would be contacted directly by a member of the Fairfield Health Department Contact Tracing Team.

Information related to case investigations is confidential and private health information will not be disclosed by FPS or the Fairfield Health Department. Health and safety protocols were followed in consultation with Sands Cleary, Director of the Fairfield Health Department, and Jill Mitchell RN, Nursing Supervisor.

The safety of our community is our priority. We are monitoring this situation closely and will continue to keep you informed of any changes or additional information.

Important Definitions:



Case: Individual who tests positive for SARS-CoV-2 by laboratory-confirmed PCR or Antigen Test.



Close Contact: Person exposed for 15 minutes or more within six feet of a Case.

School setting: classroom, other interior school location, bus stop, bus or other form of transportation, school grounds, or school-related event held at other locations.
